Each year, the event shines a spotlight on individuals whose exceptional commitment and leadership support Vision Zero's bold mission: to eliminate motor vehicle crash fatalities and serious injuries across North Dakota.

The 2025 Bismarck region winners are in the following categories:

- <u>Appreciation Award</u> This award recognizes individuals and or organizations who actively play a role in decreasing motor vehicle fatalities and serious injuries in North Dakota through their work to support Vision Zero.

- <u>Beyond the Traffic Stop Award</u> This award honors officers who used outstanding investigative skills that led to multiple arrests for narcotics, stolen property and/or outstanding warrants from a single routine traffic stop.

- <u>Infrastructure Program of the Year</u> This award recognizes a program that improves infrastructure safety to roadways, bridges or bicyclists/pedestrians throughout the state, region, a county or an organization.

- <u>Media Award</u> This award is for the reporter/news organization that has been fair, balanced and informative in reporting transportation/traffic-related issues on radio, television, newspaper or internet/social media.

- <u>Traffic Safety Officer of the Year</u> This award is for an officer who has displayed a well-rounded effort for traffic safety through enforcement, community education and training.
