- 1. Speed Check
 - a. Slow down when you approach a work zone and follow posted speed limits.
- 2. Space Check
 - a. Leave at least 2 seconds between you and the car in front of you.
- 3. Stress Check
 - a. Expect delays and plan your route (Travel Information Map) so you know where construction is occurring.
