

North Dakota Department of Transportation June 2024 Organic Social Media Post Plan – Facebook and Twitter June 1, 2024





- Avoid the "squeeze play."



- All front seat and back seat occupants must be buckled up regardless of age.
- Children younger than 8 years of age are required to ride in a child restraint (car seat or booster seat).

The primary seat belt law gets us closer to our goal of zero fatalities on North Dakota roads.
