## *Click It or Ticket* Enforcement Period Ramps up ahead of the 4<sup>th</sup> of July

*Jamestown, N.D.*- In an effort to save lives, law enforcement agencies across the state will have extra patrols from July 1 to August 12 for the *Click It or Ticket* campaign enforcing the state seat belt law.

Wearing your seat belt is the most effective way to protect yourself against serious injury or death when traveling in a vehicle. In 2017, every 7 days one unbelted vehicle occupant died in a motor vehicle crash in North Dakota.

“Summers are fun and busy, and our agency wants to remind everyone that no matter how busy you are, you should always take the time to buckle up,” says Jamestown Police Chief Scott Edinger. “Keep summer fun and prevent a tragedy from happening— buckle up.”

This effort is funded through federal grants administered by the North Dakota Department of Transportation.

Vision Zero is North Dakota’s traffic safety goal aimed at zero fatalities and serious injuries on North Dakota roads.
