U Drive. U Text. U Pay. Begins Statewide on September 4

Minot, ND- Law enforcement across the state will have extra patrols to enforce the law on distracted driving for the *U Drive U Text. U Pay* enforcement period September 4-30.

Distracted driving is dangerous and often deadly. During April's enforcement period, 174 citations were issued for distracted driving. Distracted driving takes on many forms; however, texting is one of the most common across the nation and is illegal in North Dakota.

"Distracted driving is so dangerous that when you drive distracted you are twenty-three times more at risk of a having a crash or a near-crash," said Minot Police Captain John Klug. "Drivers should take personal responsibility for themselves and others and always drive distraction free."

This campaign is part of the Vision Zero strategy to eliminate motor vehicle crash fatalities and serious injuries on North Dakota roads.
