


North Dakota Department of Transportation March 2024 Organic Social Media Post Plan – Facebook and Twitter March 1, 2024

<u>March 2</u>: In 2022, lane departure crashes resulted in 1,391 injuries and 47 fatalities. Keep yourself safe and:

- 5. Drive sober

March 18: According to North Dakota's Primary Belt Law:

- All front seat and back seat occupants must be buckled up regardless of age.
- Children younger than 8 years of age are required to ride in a child restraint (car seat or booster seat).

<u>March 24:</u> Waylyn McRae was known for his big heart and charming personality. He loved playing basketball, riding his dirt bike, and was just 32 days from turning 18. While driving home, the driver lost control on black ice, went through the median and was struck by a loaded semi tanker. All 3 boys in the vehicle passed away.
