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### **Just in time for the holidays: *Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over***

*Williston, ND* - Law enforcement across the state will have extra patrols to remove impaired drivers from the road from Dec. 18 until Jan. 31 as part of the *Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over* campaign.

Preliminary 2020 data shows fatalities from alcohol are at 32%. However, alcohol and drug-related motor vehicle crashes, fatalities and arrests are 100% preventable. Drivers should always take personal responsibility by driving sober, designating a sober driver or using a ride-hailing service.

“Make the choice to always drive sober, or make sure you have a sober ride,” says Tioga Police Chief Corey Murphy. “*Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over* is an important reminder to motorists that impaired driving tragedies are preventable.”

This campaign is part of the Vision Zero strategy to eliminate motor vehicle crash fatalities and serious injuries on North Dakota roads.
