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## **Crashes from impaired driving are preventable**

FARGO, N.D. – Over the last five years, fatalities from alcohol-related crashes in North Dakota shows an overall decreasing trend, but each of these fatalities are 100% preventable by driving sober or finding a sober ride.

Law enforcement across the state will have extra patrols to remove impaired drivers from the road during *Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over* from Dec. 14 – Jan. 31, 2023.

“Make the choice to always drive sober and avoid the serious consequences that come with driving impaired,” says Cass County Sheriff Jesse Jahner. “Driving under the influence of alcohol or drugs is preventable and should not be tolerated.”
